



The headquarter is equipped with a Thuraya IP broadband terminal, which as a native IP device connects seamlessly to the radio gateway via Ethernet cable. The satellite connection is utilised when terrestrial links are unavailable or unreliable, or when "over-the-horizon" communications are needed. Users at multiple locations can talk instantly to a pre-defined group with a single press of a button. The solution has the flexibility to provide instant, open audio or video conferences over local, wide area or global networks, and is scalable to include thousands of users.
